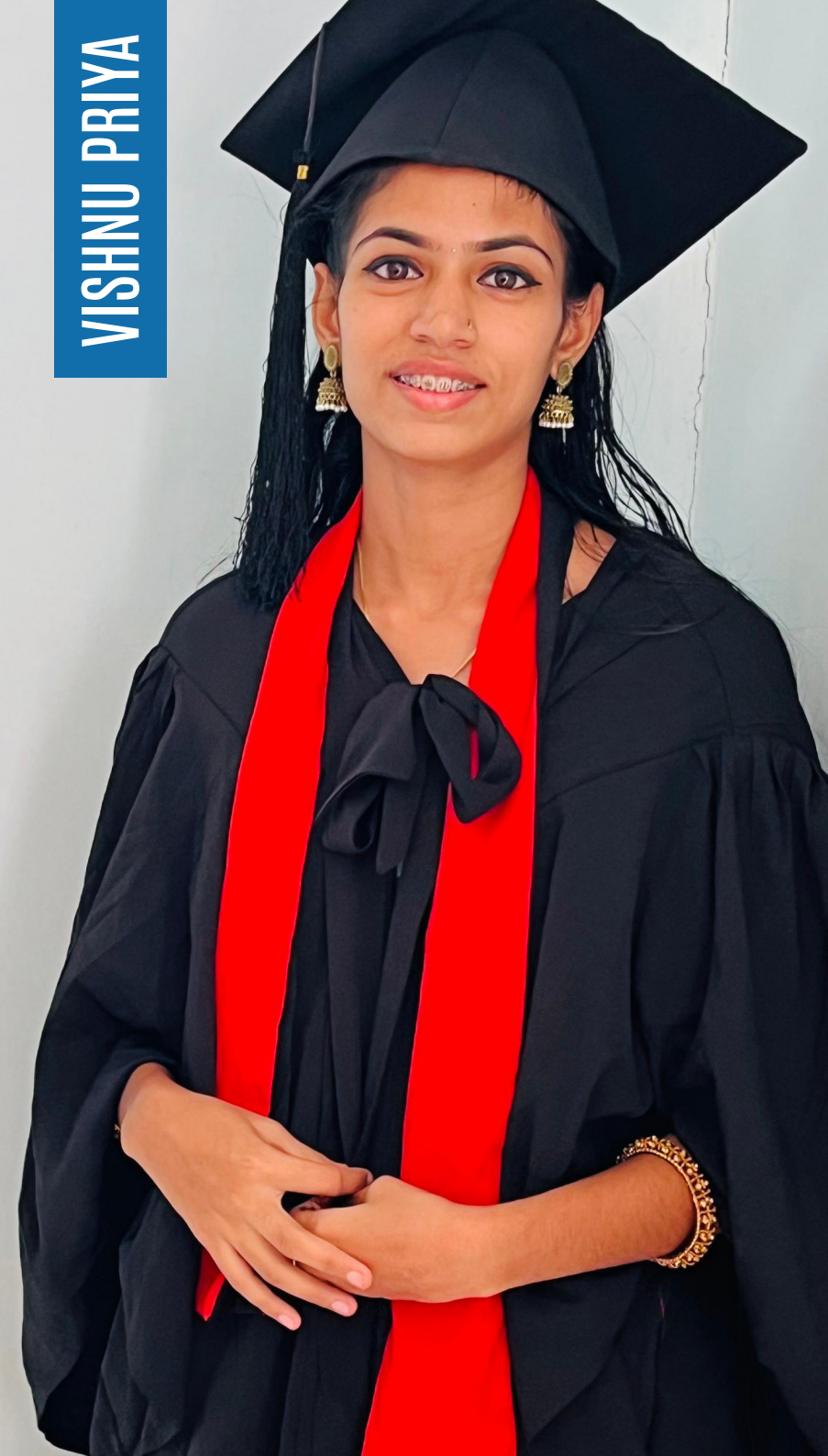

Once again, I say thank you, thanks to Namaste, and thanks to Comer Industries, with infinite gratitude for the wonderful opportunity you have given me.

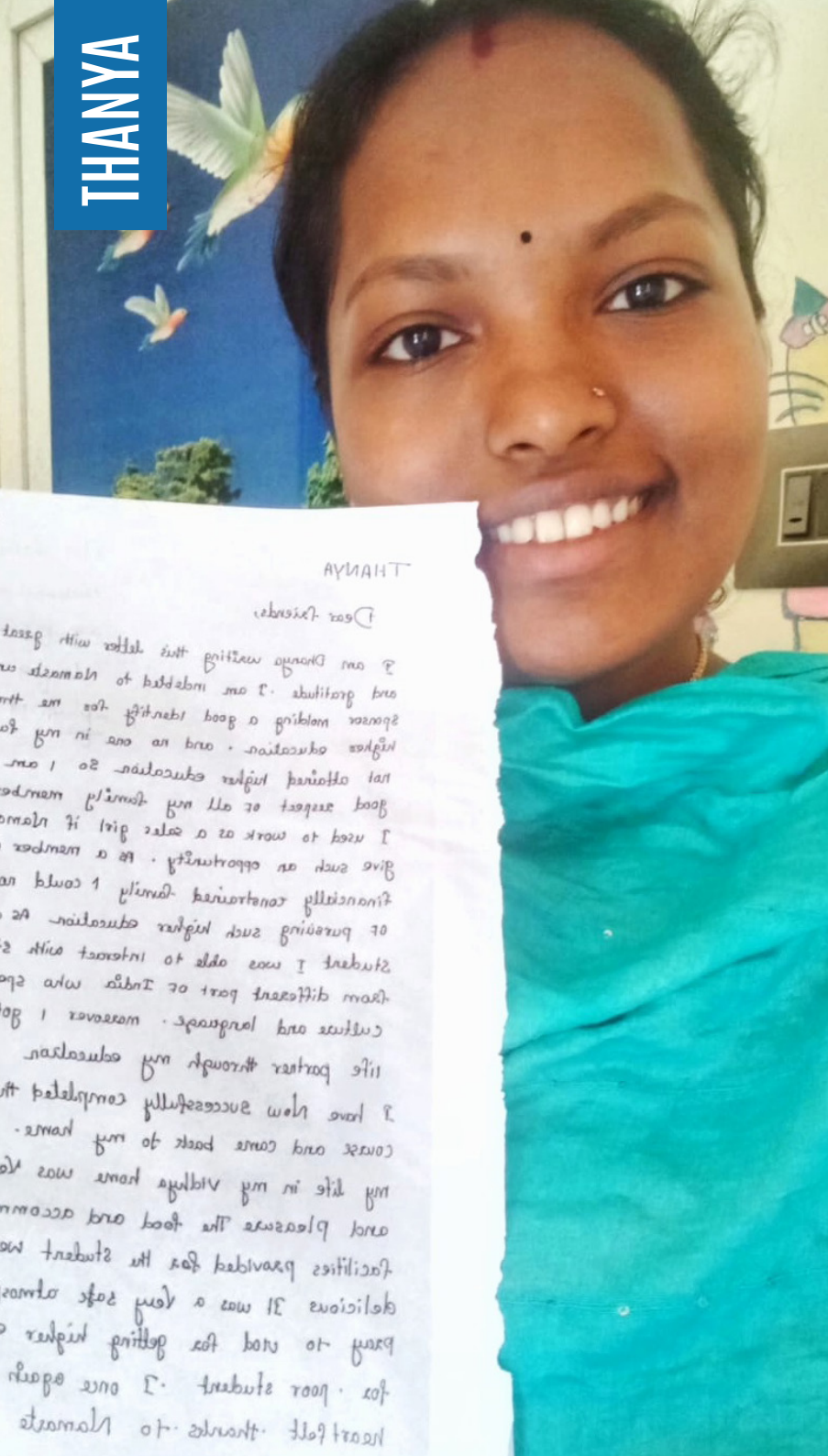
